To Whom It May Concern:

RoHS covers hazardous material elimination, in general... but more specifically, targets consumer electronic devices for elimination of lead, cadmium and other substances known to cause health problems. First as with any law there is "interpretation" as to whether we fall inside or outside of the scope of the law. In this case, regardless of whether we fall in or out... LMI Pumps are "in compliance". Statements have been solicited from the motor manufacturers, coil manufacturers, switch manufactures, cord sets, etc. and all have stated that they either are or will be compliant by the July 1st deadline of this year. The LMI controllers fall outside of the "scope" of this law...as they are not consumer electronics. In fact, we would not consider LMI Pumps to be consumer products they are used for chemical injection for commercial and industrial applications.
